

What is Bartlesville Regional United Way's Day of Caring?

Day of Caring is a time where community leaders get together to tackle much needed projects for area nonprofits. Most projects will happen on September 28th, but others can be executed before or after that date. It is a community wide day of volunteerism that anyone can be apart of!

Any 501(c)3 organization can submit their projects for selection. Multiple projects can be submitted, but each project must be submitted separately. Organizations will be responsible for coordinating details with the team that selects their project and must provide all the supplies the team will need.

Teams of volunteers will be able to start selecting their projects around the beginning of August. Team leads will need to submit all t-shirt sizes for their team members after selecting their project, as each volunteer receives a free t-shirt to wear to their project. Please keep in mind that teams cannot pre-select projects, as they will be available for selection on a first-come-first-serve basis.
